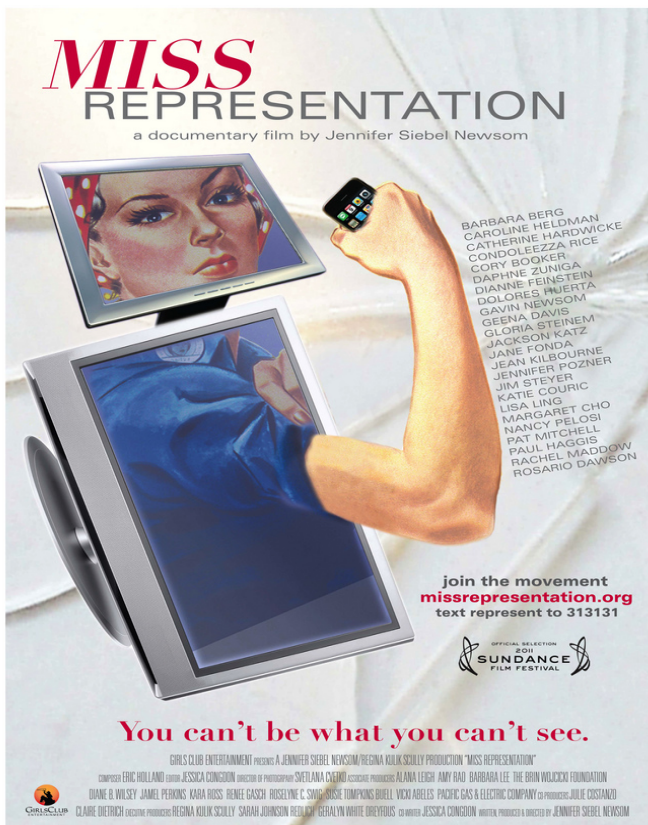

Victorian Women Lawyers welcomes you to a screening of *Miss Representation*, a documentary written, directed and produced by Jennifer Siebel Newsom, and officially selected for the Sundance Film Festival in 2011.

The film explores how mainstream media contributes to the under-representation of women in influential positions, by circulating limited and often disparaging portrayals of women.

The documentary's motto, "You can't be what you can't see" underscores an implicit message that young women need and want positive role models – and that the media has so far failed to present such role models to young women. The film is part of a social action campaign which calls for socially responsible business.

Body image is the focus of VWL's Law Reform Committee in 2015. This film screening marks the first of a series of events which will focus on body image and the law, providing opportunities to explore changes in policy and education.
